A tale of Oktoberfest

Although Oktoberfest is currently celebrated in various places around the world, it originally began in 1810 in Munich, Bavaria, Germany as a celebration of the royal marriage between King Ludwig I and Princess Therese of Saxe-Hildburghausen. It has since evolved into a 16 day long festival spanning from mid September until the first Sunday in October.

The festival celebrates Bavarian culture and with more than 6 million people attending each year, it is also considered the world's largest fair. While there, visitors are immersed in the local culture and may enjoy a wide variety of Bavarian goods including the well-known Oktoberfest beer and traditional foods such as Würstle sausage, potato pancakes called Reiberdatschi, and Sauerkraut. Although other Oktoberfest celebrations are not as long, they still give people from all walks of life the opportunity to sample the many wonderful aspects of Bavarian culture.

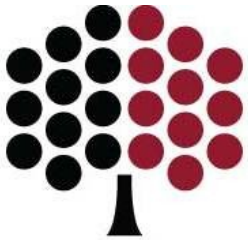
In comes Technology
