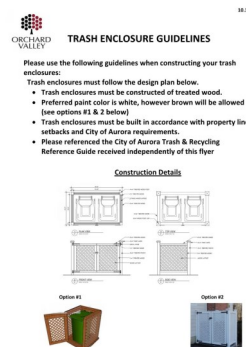
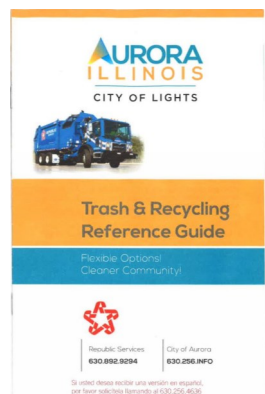

TRASH ENCLOSURE GUIDELINES

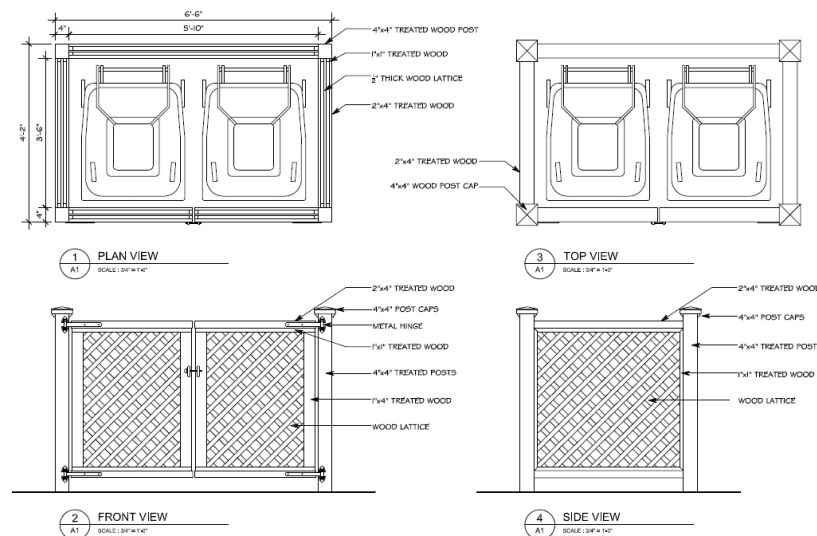
Please use the following guidelines when constructing your trash enclosures:

Trash enclosures must follow the design plan below:

- Trash enclosures must be constructed of treated wood.
- Preferred paint color is white, however brown will be allowed (see options #1 & 2 below)
- Trash enclosures must be built in accordance with property line setbacks and City of Aurora requirements.
- Trash enclosures should be located near the rear of the home
- Please referenced the City of Aurora Trash & Recycling Reference Guide received independently of this flyer

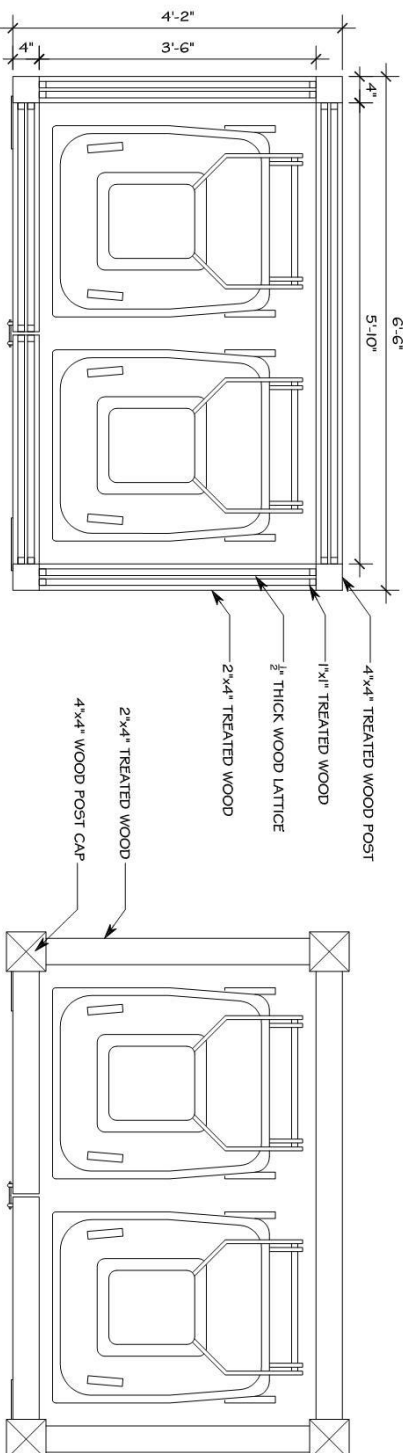
